

Primary acquired melanosis (PAM)



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Primary acquired melanosis (PAM) is an acquired pigmentation of the conjunctival epithelium. It is analogous to lentigo maligna of the skin and carries a risk of malignant transformation. PAM appears as unilateral, patchy areas of flat, brown pigmentation within the superficial conjunctiva. The areas may wax and wane over time.



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
