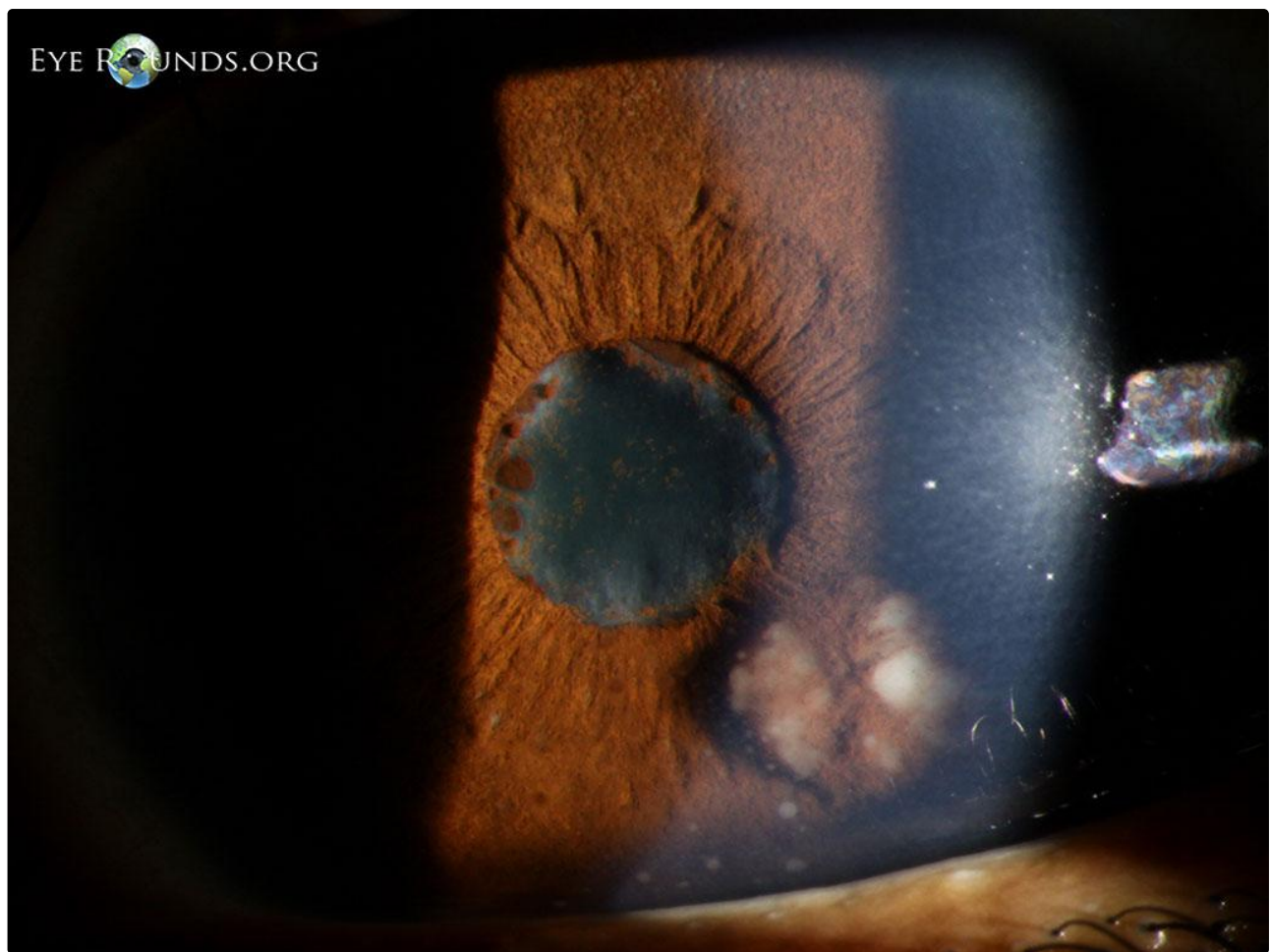


Sarcoid Uveitis
